Gina Voelker Bobrowski is a native of New Orleans, and a full –time, studio artist and Community arts practitioner who resides in Corrales, New Mexico. She received formal training at the Penland School of Crafts, Penland, North Carolina, and BFA at Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge and MFA at the University of Georgia, Athens. Her work involves utilitarian earthenware and porcelain pottery, large-scale ceramic and mixed - media sculpture, and site work and community projects.
